

Academic Record - New Students (Gr. 9 to 12)

At ISAS we implement a twelve-year American program based on a core curriculum that encourages students to recognize their potential in both the arts and sciences. At the high school level (grades 9 – 12) ISAS gives students the opportunity to further explore their curiosity with innovative elective courses while maintaining a rigorous and comprehensive core curriculum.

The core curriculum ensures that all students develop a strong foundation, whereas the elective courses are design to expand and enhance student knowledge and interest in major fields, such as engineering, medicine, business, art and music. These elective courses help students focus their passion for possible future careers.

After successfully completing 26 credits at the high school level, students graduate with a High School Diploma.
